Mary's portfolio of dance credentials includes teaching, choreographing, performing, competing, and judging locally and nationally, including at the US Open. She began her dance career competing in Ballroom and Latin, then with West Coast Swing. She ultimately earned the titles of Western Regional and National West Coast Swing Champion with her then partner, Lowell Gosser. She is the first female inductee into the California Swing Dance Hall of Fame. For the first 12 years of her competitive and teaching career she simultaneously taught grades k-5. She won the honor of Top Female Teacher, owner of The Emerald Ballroom, President of North County Swing and Ballroom Dance Club, been a longtime member of the San Diego Swing dance Club and was Dance Director for 5 years in early 2000. In 1987, Mary and Lowell were the first to introduce Argentine Tango to San Diego. They performed at many prestigious events including a Christmas Party of Pilar Wayne, (John Wayne's surviving wife) and won several Cabaret Competitions. In 2008 Mary received a special Certificate of Recognition from the California State Legislature for her contributions and achievements in dance. She has held Wednesday night dances for 17 years, is a master choreographer for Wedding First Dances, team and Pro-Am exhibitions.
