Robert & Vicki's workshop included cape swivels, a side-by-side capture with the follow in the left side, and many other patterns.




January 2015 Dance Instructor: Lloyd Lickert

They are grateful for the outstanding instruction they have received over the years, from several champion dancers, and would like to help pass on what they have learned to others.


They have recently moved to the San Diego area and are available for private lessons in their home studio in Encinitas. They are also available to teach workshops in the San Diego and southern LA areas.
