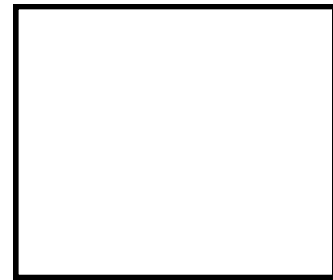
#### **Larry Armstrong**
