

She & her partner Lowell Gosser won a Western Regional and National WCS Campionship representing San Diego. She was inducted in the Calif. Swing Dance Hall of Fame in the highest category. She has judged, performed and conducted workshops at major dance conventions throughout the U.S., including the U.S. Open.

She and Lowell Gosser were the first to introduce Argentine Tango to San Diego and won several cabaret competitions at the time. She and Jerry MacCormack performed Argentine Tango for over 3000 people at the Long Beach Convention Center in 2008.

Mary is a long time member of the SDSDC & was Dance Director for 5 years. She was honored by the Calif. State Legislature for her lifetime contributions & achievements in dance.
