

Upon moving to California he was very successful in local dance contests and therefore, encouraged to be a dance Instructor. Working for McVitties he enrolled in an extensive training program learning how to be a Dance Diagnostician, not just a Dance Teacher.

Later, teaching at various night clubs and other dance studios he taught a new dance that had become popular called "The Hustle". Bob was then asked to instruct teachers. Various studios would utilize him to train their teachers the current dances that would be out at that time.

One of his favorite dances is the West Coast Swing. The mastering of multiple dances has enabled him to incorporate other dance moves into the West Coast Swing causing it to be an exceptional dance requiring the least effort on the dance floor.

Brandy Richey intermediate workshop on October 21st

Brandy Richev started dancing at 15. training in International, American Ballroom and Latin. Shortly thereafter she realized that dance was more than a hobby, it was a passion motivating her to learn all styles of partner dancing. She studied and trained with world renowned champions and began teaching by the age of 17. Soon after, she ventured into Country Western competing in Division 1 and ranking 4th in the world. After that her love for performing led her to the Salsa community, where she brought her knowledge of other dance styles. In 2002 Brandy and her dance partner started the first Salsa dance company in Phoenix AZ. The Company has since traveled across the U.S. teaching, performing, and competing. It was at a Salsa/West Coast



Swing convention that she found herself dancing more Swing and realized she found another amazing dance. She now mainly dances West Coast Swing, residing in San Diego, California where she teaches and competes.
