Fortunately for us, Margie later became fascinated with partner dancing, especially "the spontaneous lead/follow connection, and how it worked in social settings." After having trained in multiple styles of swing, and obtaining

sufficient refinement, she become an instructor. She has added other club and ballroom dance styles to repertoire. Described by all who know her as both "an exceptional instructor, and stylish dancer, one that moves with intention and grace." Margie has been a professional dance instructor in San Diego for twenty years offering weekly classes and private lessons. For ten of those years, she has traveled through Europe teaching and performing as an international guest instructor at dance festivals and conventions in France, Germany, Belgium, Switzerland, Austria and Scotland. She also created a new opportunity for local San Diego dancers when she cocreated and directed the SwingFX dance team, creating original choreographies and providing dance entertainment for corporate, public and private events here in the San Diego Area for seven years - Continued


FROM YOUR ACTIVITIES DIRECTOR MARY
