Bachata club for over 20-years and substituting at many other venues. He has also performed at the Pampas Argentine Restaurant's Tango Dinner show for over 15-years completing 1000 dinner shows! Michael has performed in well over 2,500 different shows in just over 25-years! Many were benefits or fundraisers of which he is most proud.
