

Margie Adams began her dance training in San Diego in her youth, training in classical ballet, tap and contemporary dance. Later she became fascinated with social dancing and the idea of communicating through the connection with a dance partner. Her love of dancing led her to several great dance experiences



including artistic director & choreographer for her SwingFX performance dance team providing swing dance entertainment for hire for corporate & private events for several years. She also hosted the Swing Jam Friday weekly dance venue for many years and the Jitterbug club weekly dance venue when it moved to the Dance for 2 studio. Margie's skills on the dance floor and her teaching skills unexpectedly also opened the door to becoming an annual international guest instructor at major European dance conventions in France and Germany for 10 years and at requested workshop weekends in Lucerne, London, Brussels, Bern, Paris, Vienna and Edinburgh. Described by those who know her, Margie is an exceptional instructor and stylish dancer. Her students return to her classes and often refer her to others. She offers weekly classes and is available for private lessons in west coast swing, nightclub two step, wedding dance, lindy, balboa, cha cha and foxtrot. She also teaches a special

The girls and I would go to conventions and every once in a while I would go to LA to dance. One of the places was the Pressbox in Westminster. What fun!! I had a hip replacement about 10 years ago. I was diagnosed with colon cancer, which was removed, but they found a little on my liver which they are treating now. That's why I don't dance much.
